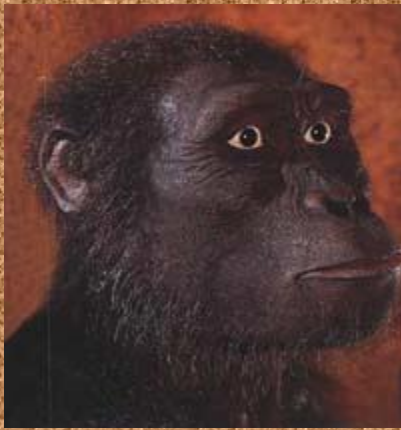

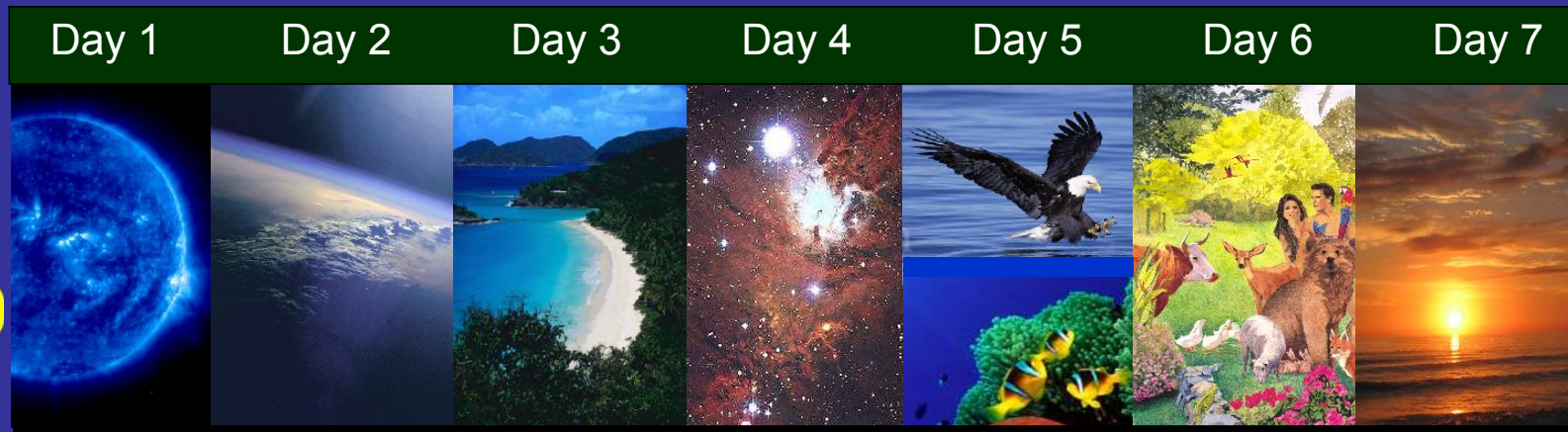

THE WAY “DAY” IS USED IN THE BIBLE

- The opposite of night
- A period of time in the future
- The total days of creation
- A literal day

EVENING AND MORNING

The words “evening” and “morning” are used together in the Old Testament with the word “day” (*yom*) over 100 times in non-prophetical literature. Each time “day” refers to a literal, 24-hour day.

DAY THREE OF CREATION

Genesis 1:9-13

**God made “grass, flowers,
and trees.”**

GENESIS 1:14

Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, **and for days and years.**”

“DAY” MODIFIED BY A NUMBER

“We have failed to find a single example of the use of the word ‘day’ in the entire Scripture where it means other than a period of twenty-four hours when modified by the use of the numerical adjective.”

PLURAL OF “DAY”

The word “day” (*yom*) appears in its plural form (*yammim*) **over 700 times** in the Old Testament. It always means a literal 24-hour day when it is found in non-prophetic literature like Genesis.

EXODUS 20:8-11

“Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. **Six days** you shall labor and do all your work.... **For in six days** the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and **all that is in them**, and rested the seventh day.”

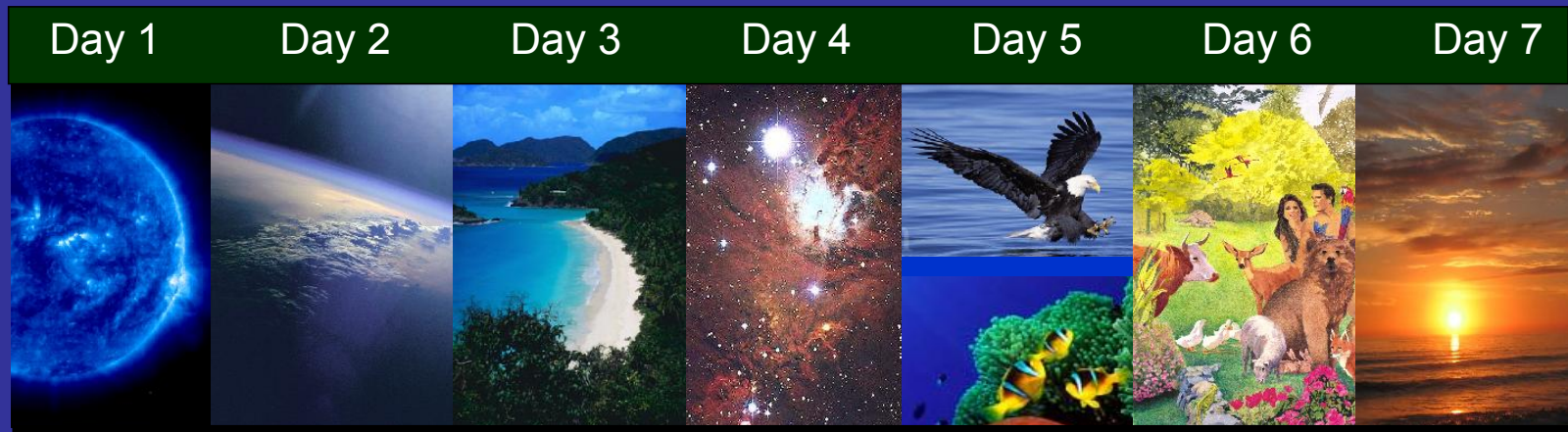

Even evolutionists would not place the billions of years needed for their theory after the arrival of man.



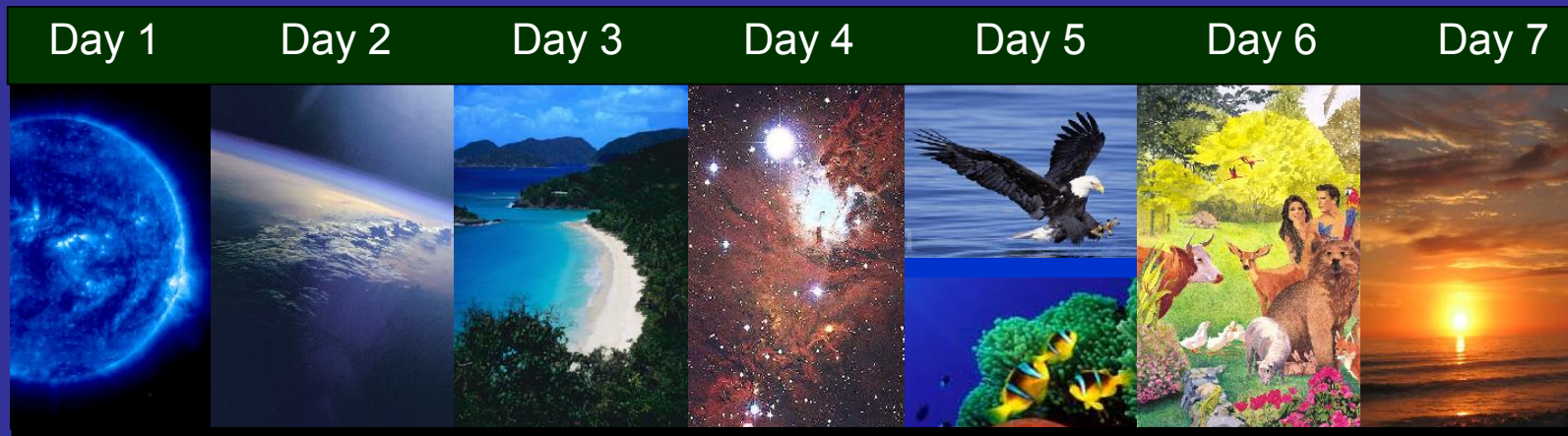
MAN AND THE AGE OF THE EARTH
